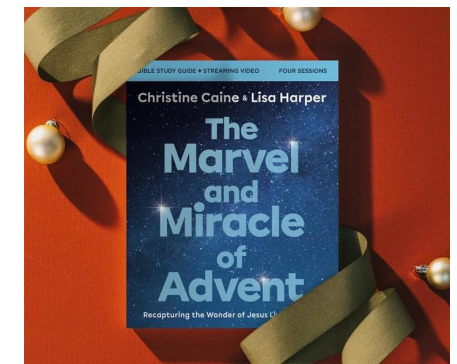

The Fellowship of the Believers

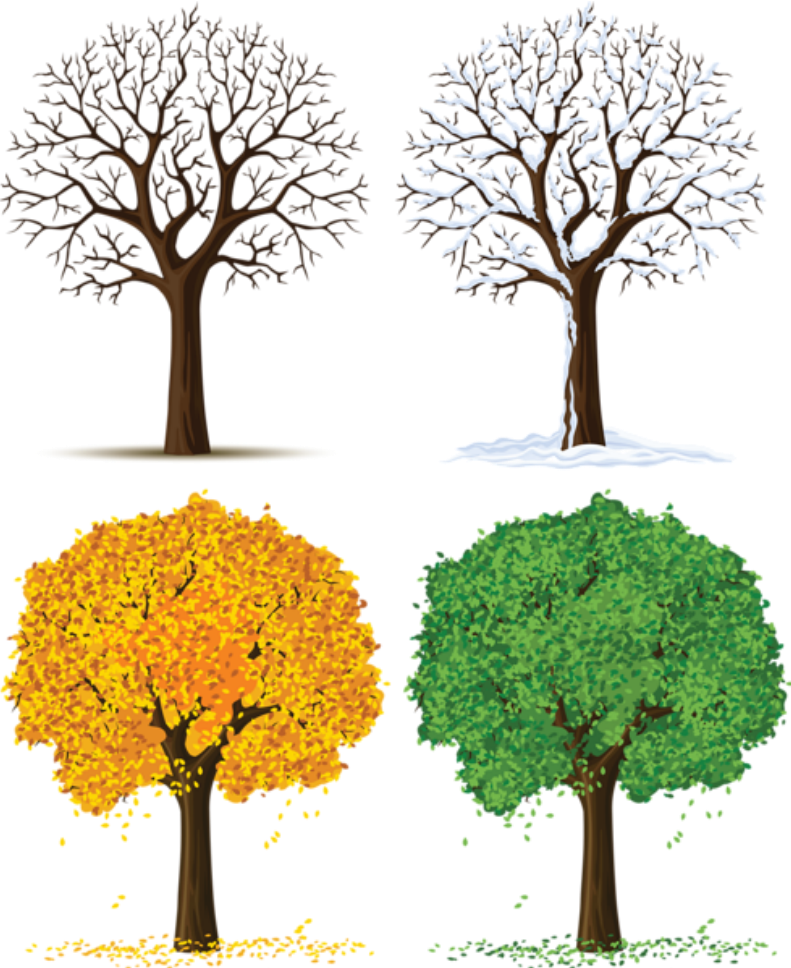
