John 4:19-24

19 “Sir,” the woman said, “I can see that you are a prophet. 20 Our ancestors worshiped on this mountain, but you Jews claim that the place where we must worship is in Jerusalem.”

21 “Woman,” Jesus replied, “believe me, a time is coming when you will worship the Father neither on this mountain nor in Jerusalem. 22 You Samaritans worship what you do not know; we worship what we do know, for salvation is from the Jews. 23 Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. 24 God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth.”

**Series Title: “Empowered to Serve:

Sermon 1: “The Gift-Giver”

Text: 1 Corinthians 12:1–11
Focus: God as the source of spiritual gifts; introduction to what spiritual gifts are and why they matter.
Big Idea: Spiritual gifts are given by the Holy Spirit for the good of the church and the glory of God.

Sermon 2: “One Body, Many Parts”

Text: 1 Corinthians 12:12–27
Focus: Unity and diversity in the body of Christ.
Big Idea: Every believer has a role, and every gift matters. No one is insignificant.

Sermon 3: “Gifts with Order and Purpose”

Text: 1 Corinthians 14:1–33
Focus: Using spiritual gifts in a way that builds up the church.
Big Idea: Spiritual gifts should bring clarity, not confusion-and always edify the body.

Sermon 4: “Equipped to Build”

Text: Ephesians 4:11–16
Focus: Leadership gifts and equipping the saints.
Big Idea: Gifts are for equipping others, not exalting ourselves.

Sermon 5: “Serving in the Strength God Provides”

Text: Romans 12:3–8; 1 Peter 4:10–11
Focus: Serving with humility, grace, and dependence on God.
Big Idea: We serve not in our strength but in God’s, as faithful stewards of His grace
