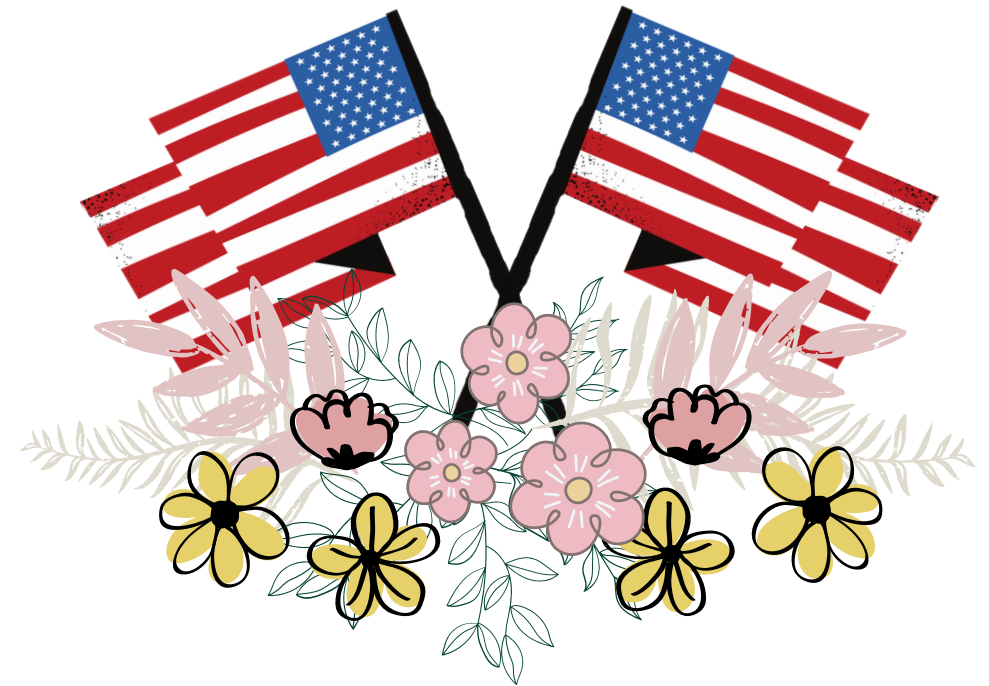
- ¹ May the Lord answer you when you are in distress;
