Did you know... John Wesley was born in June, 17, 1703 and died March 2, 1791. His birthday is celebrated on our church calendar today, June 28th
The reason for the two dates comes down to a calendar change:

- June 17 (Old Style): The exact date he was born in 1703 while Great Britain still used the Julian calendar.
- June 28 (New Style): The date his birthday became after Great Britain switched to the Gregorian calendar in 1752. Wesley himself celebrated his birthday on June 28 for the rest of his life.

John Wesley was an Anglican clergyman, evangelist, and founder, with his brother Charles, of the Methodist movement in the Church of England. Methodism, 18th-century movement founded by John Wesley that sought to reform the Church of England from within. The movement, however, became separate from its parent body and developed into an autonomous church.
