

Luke 5:1-11 niv Jesus Calls His First Disciples

⁵ One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, the people were crowding around him and listening to the word of God. ² He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets. ³ He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore. Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat.

⁴ When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch."

⁵ Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets."

⁶ When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break.

⁷ So they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink.

⁸ When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, "Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!" ⁹ For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken, ¹⁰ and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners.

Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people." ¹¹ So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.

Week 2 (19): "Faith in the Storm"

Text: Mark 4:35-41

Theme: Trusting Christ when life feels out of control. The presence of Jesus is greater than the power of the storm. What does your fear reveal about your faith?

Week 3 (July 26): "Walking Where Faith Begins"

Text: Matthew 14:22-33

Theme: Stepping out in faith. Faith grows when our eyes remain fixed on Jesus rather than the waves. What "boat" is God asking you to step out of?

Did you know... "Trust and Obey" was written in 1886 by Presbyterian minister John H. Sammis and composed by Daniel B. Towner. It was inspired during a Dwight L. Moody revival in Brockton, Massachusetts, when a young man stood and simply testified: "I am not quite sure—but I am going to trust, and I am going to obey." The stirring phrase was jotted down by Towner, who sent it to Sammis to construct the lyrics. The classic hymn was first published in 1887 in the collection Hymns New and Old and quickly became a staple in evangelical worship.
